Internship Application Process (Abroad)

(A Step-by-Step overview, detailed information of steps 2, 5, 6 and 7 are available below)

- Step 1: What are the requirements?
- Check your curriculum for your study programme's internship tasks & learning objectives.
- Step 2: Find an internship abroad
- Use your network and ask your lecturers.
- Always have a **Plan B** in case your first choice doesn't work out.
- Step 3: Discuss terms with the company
- Agree on tasks, expectations, and requirements.
- Use the **Internship agreement** to ensure clarity.
- Step 4: Get approval from your internship supervisor and the company
- Your internship coordinator/supervisor must review and approve your agreement.
- **☑** Step 5: Apply online for your Erasmus internship grant
- Check **Canvas** for the correct link & deadline.
- You must apply for an Erasmus grant at least 5 weeks before the start of your internship.
- Step 6: Get visas & apply for other grants (if applicable)
- Apply for grants, visa, and necessary documents.
- non-EU internship visas can take up to 3 months and may be expensive.
- Step 7: Plan logistics & insurance
- Travel & Accommodation: Do not book anything until your internship is officially approved.
- Insurance: Make sure you have accident, health, and liability insurance.
