



## Examples of functional impairments and support options

The table shows examples of support options and functional impairments, as well as the documentation you should submit with your application. The form is indicative and not exhaustive, and the allocation of support will always be based on a concrete and individual assessment.

Documentation is a prerequisite but not a guarantee that your application will be successful.

Functional impairment	Documentation	Support options via SPS **
<b>Dyslexia *</b>	The result of your dyslexia test (possibly the extended test).	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– IntoWords</li> <li>– OCR framework at Nota.</li> <li>– Introduction to IntoWords (2–6-hour course)</li> <li>– Study support hours at IKH</li> </ul>
<b>Number blindness (dyscalculia)*</b>	Test result/report from your test.	Academic support hours (often 20 hours per semester) with someone from Business Academy Aarhus
<b>Mental/neurological functional impairment</b> ADHD/ADD Autism Bipolar disorder OCD Anxiety Depression Borderline Schizophrenia etc.	Please attach documentation from your own doctor, specialist or hospital where your diagnosis is documented.	Academic support hours (often 20 or 30 hours per semester) with a lecturer from Business Academy Aarhus.
<b>Physical functional impairment</b> Back pain Visually impaired Hearing impaired Mobility impaired etc.	Documentation from your own doctor, specialist or hospital stating what the challenge is and what can be done to alleviate the condition.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– Height-adjustable table</li> <li>– Special chair</li> <li>– Secretary hours</li> <li>– Practical help</li> <li>– Digital aids and assistance</li> <li>– Sign language interpreter</li> <li>– Writing interpreter</li> <li>– Hearing system / FM system</li> </ul>
<b>Neurological disorder</b> Concussion Migraines etc.	Please attach documentation from your own doctor, specialist or hospital where your diagnosis is documented.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– Ergonomic chair</li> <li>– Height-adjustable table</li> <li>– Ergonomic keyboard</li> <li>– Laptop holder for portable PC</li> <li>– Lamps etc.</li> </ul>

\* If you have not been tested for dyslexia or dyscalculia, you can contact the SU and SPS office to have a test done.

\*\* SPS applications are decided by the Agency for Education and Quality based on an individual assessment.
